



A fixture in whitewater videos and magazines, Erica is one of the more visible members of Team Wave Sport. Erica maintains a grueling competition schedule and teaches paddling clinics while still finding time to attend college.

jimmy blakeney



Jimmy wasted no time showing what the XXX can do. He paddled it to victories on the Yampa, Boulder Creek, Potomac and Ocoee. Jimmy has appeared in numerous paddling videos, where he's featured not only for his paddling skills, but for his talent on a snowboard or skateboard. A threat to win any freestyle event, he's also an instructor who teaches playpaddling clinics across the country.




chris emerick






taylor robertson


tanya shuman
